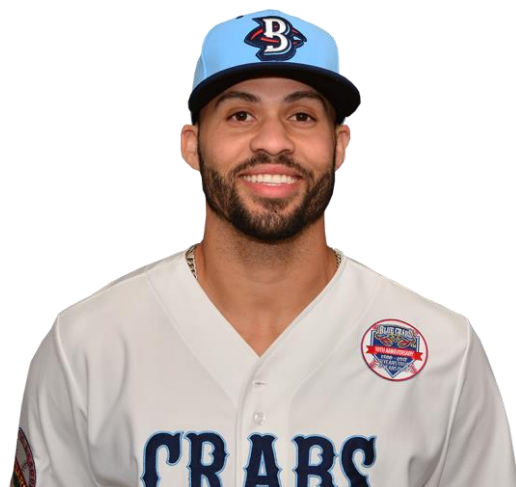

Cory Vaughn is a professional baseball player who has played in the major and minor leagues. As the son of MLB star Greg Vaughn, the goal of playing in the majors came to him naturally. He attended San Diego State University and was drafted in the fourth round of the 2010 MLB Amateur Draft by the New York Mets where he spent six seasons, reaching the Triple-A affiliate and the Las Vegas 51s. While with the Mets, he hit .246 with 75 HR and 75 SB. In 2016, he played for the New Jersey Jackals of the Canadian-American Association, hitting .256 with 9 HR, 57 RBIs, and 13 SB; and led the team in doubles, 27, and outfield assists, 6. This year, Cory joined the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs.

Cory was diagnosed with T1D at age 11. He thought his opportunity to play baseball was over when he was first diagnosed, but support and encouragement from his parents and diabetes care team helped to reassure him that he would still pursue all of his goals.

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
